

USER POLICY

Anyone may submit contents and/or ask questions on this page. We undertake to answer at least three questions per month.

The moderator of this forum has the duty to recognize everyone's opinion. However, in order to foster beneficial, transparent dialogues, sound judgment and mutual respect must prevail.

Anyone who posts content is expected to comply with the regulations set out herein and to clearly identify herself/himself. Non-compliance with the above may result in deletion of the entry and/or exclusion from the forum.

A. Observance of the topic discussed in the forum

Any input to discussions must be in line with the topic of the forum, that is the Énergie Saguenay Project and its economic, social and environmental impacts.

Off-topic discussions must not be encouraged; the moderation team could delete these entries.

B. Observance of the exchange format: *Questions and Answers (Q&A)*

The purpose of the forum is to address public concerns and inquiries with regard to the Énergie Saguenay Project. We therefore ask participants to formulate their entries as questions, and to limit their texts to 160 characters.

Non-compliant submissions will not be published.

C. Respect for the moderation team

Disrespectful, degrading, and/or obviously unfounded comments shall not be admitted. Constructive debates, regardless of differences, can only be achieved through courteous, measured, and weighted opinions.

D. Compliance with laws

Illegal, violent, obscene and/or discriminatory contents shall not be tolerated. Any and all entries of this nature shall be systematically deleted.

E. Respect for publishing regulations

Hypertext links without any context should be avoided. Users are asked to add context to any link they may want to publish in an effort to make the exchanges and debates more interesting for participants.

Repeating the same messages should be avoided as this needlessly encumbers the forum and is a waste of time for users.

All inputs must be in French, well written and coherent. “Texting”-style (SMS) language shall not be accepted, nor will swear words. Capital letter usage should be kept to a minimum.

Language quality (spelling, grammar, syntax, verb tenses, and paragraphs) should be prioritized. Well-written, intelligible texts are more likely to spark interest among forum participants.

F. Moderation team

The moderation team’s mandate is to see to the observance of the above instructions. Their interpretative authority is discretionary and, if necessary, they will reinforce these rules.

Non-compliance with the rules herein could lead to entries being refused or deleted.
